* **CONCOLOR FIR:** Excellent ornamental or Christmas tree. Has flat, soft green to deep blue citrus-scented needles. Hardy because it withstands dry periods and high temperatures. 5 year old seedlings. Size: 12-15."

* **NORWAY SPRUCE:** Fastest growing of all spruces. Develops pyramidal shape and strong graceful branches that are covered with dark green needles. Ideal windbreaker that likes full sun and grows in various soils. Matures at 60 feet and has a beautiful 25 foot spread. 3 year old seedlings. Size: 6-10."

* **SCOTCH PINE:** This conifer should grow 60 to 70 feet in height, with a spread of 15 to 20 feet. Short, pointed green to blue-green foliage. Good winter color. Branches are stiff and durable. Best in well drained soils but tolerates poor soils such as sandy, rocky and even heavy clay very well. Extremely hardy and disease resistant also drought tolerant. Plant in full sun. Valued as an ornamental and landscape plant. 2 year old seedlings. Size: 6-8."

* **EASTERN REDCEDAR:** Pyramidal evergreen growing up to 50 feet. Medium green needles are flat and scale-like. Handsome grayish to reddish brown bark is considered part of its ornamental interest. 2 year old seedlings. Size: 6-8."

* **PIN OAK:** Named for its small, thin, dead branches that stick out like pins from the main trunk. This is among the most widely planted and fastest-growing native oaks. It tolerates drought, poor soils and is easy to transplant. Popular because of an attractive shape and trunk. The green, glossy leaves show brilliant red to bronze fall color. 2 year old seedlings. Size: 1-2 ft.

* **WINTERBERRY:** Winterberry is a deciduous shrub growing to 6-15 feet tall and often as wide. It develops a rounded habit through suckering, eventually growing into a sizeable colony of upright stems. The stems tend to be dark brown and often develop a pleasing gray sheen. The three inch long, elliptic, toothed, and pointed leaves vary from light to dark green, taking a yellow hue in autumn. Offers bright red berries in late summer. The berries, for which the common name was derived, remain after leaf fall and persist into the winter months to provide food for wildlife. Winterberry prefers evenly moist, acid soils in full sun to partial shade. 3 year old seedlings. Size: 8-10."

* **WHITE FLOWERING DOGWOOD:** Prolific, large, pure white, overlapping petal-like blooms in spring, dark green foliage in summer, red-purple leaves in fall and glossy red berries that persist into winter make this a lovely ornamental tree for all seasons. It has a short trunk, horizontal branches, and a moderately globe-shaped crown. The dense branching provides shade and nesting sites, fruit and buds are a favorite with dozens of bird species, and the nectar and pollen attract butterflies. Dogwoods prefer acidic, moist, well drained sites with partial shade, but will take full sun. 2 year old seedlings. Size: 6-8."

* **AMERICAN SWEETGUM:** Attractive deciduous tree of the Witch Hazel family that ranges in height from 60 to 100 feet with a narrow oval canopy. It has a moderate to rapid growth rate, putting on a height at a rate of 1 to 4 feet a year for the first 5 to 10 years and 12 to 15 inches per year. Leaves are deeply lobed and star-shaped. 2 year old seedlings. Size: 12-15."

* **RED MAPLE:** This maple grows at a moderate to rapid rate and does best in bright sun to partial shade. It will grow in a range of soil types from sandy loam to clay. Better soil will result in a better healthier tree. The tree has a pyramidal shape when young. When the tree matures it will attain a larger more rounded crown and will grow to a size of 40-60 feet with a width of 25-45 feet. Leaves turn a brilliant red during fall and accent any yard. 2 year old seedlings. Size: 6-8."

* **OSAGE ORANGE:** Very fast, vigorous growth 20 to 40 feet, occasionally over 60 feet. Distinguished for its yellow green, orange-shaped inedible fruit, which appears in fall, often used for dried decorative arrangements. Fall foliage is brilliant yellow. Often used for windbreaks or fence rows, due to its fast, dense growth and heavy thorns, which make an impenetrable barrier against people and livestock. 2 year old seedlings. Size: 4-8."

* **AMERICAN BEECH:** Slow to medium growth up to 50 to 70 feet. Spread 30 to 40 feet. Native from Ontario, south to Florida and Texas. Dense, pyramidal growth. Likes moist, well drained soil. Silvery green leaves changing to dark green in summer. Fall color is golden bronze. Three winged nut enjoyed by wildlife such as turkey. 2 year old seedlings. Size: 10-15."

* **ELDERBERRY:** Vigorous fast growing shrub to 10 feet in height. Spread 6 to 8 feet. Needs plenty of room to grow and is not considered a landscaping plant. Hosts clusters of bluish-black berries in late summer. Used for making jelly, preserves and wine. They are also a food source for wildlife and grows in various soils. Wetland tolerant. 2 year old seedling. Size: 12-15."

* **GINGKO:** Grows to 50 to 80 feet. Fan-shaped leaves turn clear yellow in fall. Grows best in well drained soil. This tree is becoming more common as a specimen plant and along streets and highways. Slow growth will not get out of bounds and interfere with power lines, etc. It has a very picturesque, wide spreading, open habit. Ginkgo is not infested with any insect or disease. Ginkgo trees begin flowering and fruiting at age 30. 2 year old seedlings. Size: 4-8."
