Your purchase is appreciated! These quality seedlings increase property value, enhance wildlife habitat, beautify the landscape, improve the environment, and can provide a source of income. Proceeds directly support the programs and projects of Sweet Arrow Lake County Park. The Sweet Arrow Lake Conservation Association and Schuylkill Conservation District work together on this sale.

- **DOUGLAS FIR:** Beautiful, symmetrical evergreen that makes an excellent Christmas and landscaping tree. Grows fast in moist, well-drained soil. 4 year old seedlings. Size: 20-30"
- **CONCOLOR FIR:** Extremely popular and hardy tree. Excellent as an ornamental or Christmas tree. Has flat, soft green to deep blue fragrant needles. Withstands dry periods and high temps better than other firs. 3 year old seedlings. Size: 10-24."
- **COLORADO BLUE SPRUCE:** Handsome ornamental or Christmas tree with blue-green needles. Great for wildlife cover. Likes ordinary soil, average moisture, and full sun. 4 year old seedlings. Size: 10-20."
- **NORWAY SPRUCE:** Fastest growing of the spruces. Develops pyramidal shape and strong graceful branches that are covered with dark green needles. Ideal windbreaker. Likes full sun and grows in various soils. Matures at 60' and has a beautiful 25' spread. 4 year old seedlings. Size: 15-30."
- **AMERICAN CRANBERRY:** This is an excellent deciduous shrub for screening up to 10 to 12 feet high. It grows to a width of 8 feet with very dense growth of up to 3 feet per year in full sun or part shade. American Cranberry Bush has showy white flowers in spring followed by red berries in fall and winter. These berries hang through mid winter making excellent bird feed. This shrub has very few insect problems and prefers good, well-drained soil. For best growth, provide supplemental water during dry periods. For a solid screen, plant bushes 2 to 3 ft. apart. 2 year old seedlings. Size: 12-24."
- **RED OAK:** It is the most important oak, primarily used in timber production for use in flooring, furniture, and construction. It is most recognized by dark, reddish brown bark that is deeply ridged, giving it the appearance of stripes. A fast grower, a 10 year old tree can be upwards to 20 feet tall under optimal growing conditions, with mature trees reaching a height between 60 and 75 feet. Also long living, the red oak is estimated to live upwards to 500 years. Produces brilliant red foliage in the fall and acorns for wildlife. 2 year old seedlings. Size: 12-24."
- **WHITE OAK:** Tall, nicely-shaped tree with nice red fall color and large acorns. It is a slow-growing tree that is excellent for ornamental use or for timber. White oaks are known to live almost 600 years! 2 year old seedlings. Size: 12-28."
- **RED BUD:** Red Bud grows as a small tree that displays an abundance of purple blossoms in the spring. It has large heart shaped leaves during the summer, and long seed pods in the fall. 2 year old seedlings. Size: 10-24."
- **KOUSA DOGWOOD:** This handsome small tree adds year-round beauty. White flowers in May and June give a milky way effect; purple and scarlet fall leaves add intense color. Beautiful tree form, with horizontal branching. Enjoys partial shade to full sun. Produces seeds enjoyed by birds. Grows to 15' - 25.' 3 year old seedlings. Size: 22-42."
- **RED OSIER DOGWOOD:** Grows well in saturated soils as a small to medium sized shrub with bright red twigs. Very good for stream bank erosion control. The fruit consists of clusters of white berries in July and August and is preferred by many species of song birds and game birds. Mature height: to 12'. 3 year old seedlings. Size: 28-40."
- **ARROWWOOD:** Arrowwood viburnum is a flowering shrubs that bears a white flower in spring and attractive fall foliage and clustered bluish berries in fall. It reaches a height of 6'-15', with a similar spread. These shrubs are amazingly versatile and tolerate a range of soils, including wet soils. They can be grown in full sun, partial shade or full shade. Good for butterflies and wild birds for cover and food. 3 year old seedlings. Size: 10-24."
- **BLACK CHERRY:** These seedlings grow very fast. In a few years they will grow to 20 feet tall! The leaves are glossy green, fine toothed, simple oval to oblong, and alternate. Small white flowers appear in March. The fruit is small, red and then black when ripe, and are in long drooping clusters. Berries are juicy, strong flavored, but rather palatable and can be used for jelly or syrup. Birds love them! One year old seedlings. Size: 6-16."
